Section A. Purpose and Scope

This INSTRUCTION lists the authorities relating to the nondisability retirement of PHS commissioned officers and the officials who may exercise these authorities.

33.601	Approve retirement of an officer who has 25 years of service after serving four years in the Surgeon General, Deputy Surgeon General or Assistant Surgeon General grades under authority of Section 211(a)(5) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 212(a)(5)) and Section 1(e) of E.O. 11140.		S (P)
33.602	Act on the recommendation of a retirement board that an officer be voluntarily or involuntarily retired after 20 or more years of service under authority of Section 211(a)(3) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 212(a)(3)) and PHS Regulations prescribed in Subchapter CC43.8, Il, CCPM.	**1/22/79	Dir, OM/PHS
33.603	Approve the retirement of a Full grade Regular Corps officer who twice fails permanent promotion to the Senior grade for other than physical reasons under authority of Section 210(g)(3) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 211(g)(3)).	7/31/78	Dir, CPOD/ OPM/OM
33.604	Approve the involuntary retirement of a permanent Senior grade Regular Corps officer in a nonrestricted category with 30 or more years of service under authority of PHS Regulations prescribed in Subchapter CC43.8, Il, CCPM. 33.606	Act on the recommendations of a retirement board that a permanent Director grade Regular Corps officer with 30 or more years of service (other than an officer during the period of his/her assignment in the grade of ASG or above or who is in the Senior Grade in a restricted grade) be retired involuntarily under authority of Section 211(a)(2) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 212(a)(2)) and PHS Regulations prescribed in Subchapter CC43.8, 11, CCPM.	7/31/78	Dir, CPOD/ OPM/OM
