33.702	Approve temporary disability retirement under authority of 10 U.S.C. 1202 and 1205 and Section 221(b) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 213a(b)).	**1/22/79	Dir, OM/PHS
33.703	Approve permanent disability retirement under authority of 10 U.S.C. 1201 and 1204 and Section 221(b) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 213a(b)).	**1/22/79	Dir, OM/PHS
33.704	Determine the physical fitness for continued active service of officers referred to medical review boards under authority of 10 U.S.C. 1216(b)(1).	**1/22/79	Dir, OM/PHS
