The prescreen application is best viewed with Internet Explorer 8.0.6001 and above. It is also tested to work under the following browsers.


- IE 7 Version: 7.0.5730

- Safari 5.0.3 (windows operating system)
- Firefox version 3.6.8
- Opera 10.63

NOTE: Currently this application is not tested to work in MAC operating System


Setting for Internet Explorer Version: 8.0.6001

1. In **Tools** menu, click **Internet Options**



2. In Internet Options window, select Security Tab and click Custom Level...




3. In security settings – Internet Zone Dialog Box, click Enable for Active Scripting in the scripting section and click OK




4. Click OK once again to save your internet option settings

1. On the Tools menu, Click Options...





2. On the **Content** tab, click to select **Enable Javascript** Checkbox

4. **For changes to be effective, close Firefox and restart.**

Setting for Google Chrome Version: 8.0.552.237

1.	Click the  icon at the top right of your screen
2.	Select Options .
3.	In Google Chrome Options dialog window, select Under the Hood tab. 
4.	In Content Settings dialog window, Click JavaScript Under features
5.	Click to Select Allow all Sites to run Javascript (recommended) and click close 
6.	Finally click Close once more.
7.	For changes to be effective, close chrome and restart .


Settings for Safari (windows) Version: 5.0.3

1. Click the  icon at the top right of your screen to view general safari setting.

4. Check all checkboxes displayed next to WebContent:




5. Click  to close the window
