READINESS AND DUTY REQUIREMENTS (CCI 241.01), DEPLOYMENT PREPARATION PLAN

Know that the Deployment Preparation Plan (DPP),
formerly known as the Family Care Plan, is a new
readiness requirement that will be effective December
2022.

Know that all U.S. Public Health Service Commissioned
Corps Officers will be required to complete and submit
an initial DPP during their birth month after the
effective date of December 2022.

Know that a DPP is valid for twelve months and is required to be updated when a change in circumstances occurs (i.e., new family member, divorce, dependent parent).

Know that Officers must maintain a DPP and be prepared to submit to CCHQ when advised.
