Commissaries

Commissaries are supermarkets, usually located on military installations, that sell food, sundry and cleaning products for cost plus a 5 percent surcharge to active-duty military, guard and reserve members, retirees and qualified family members.



Exchanges

Coast Guard Exchange, Marine Corps Exchange, Army and Air Force exchange service (AAFES), Navy Exchanges (NEX), and Shoppettes are all examples of military exchange stores. The exchange is the military department and drug store. Military personnel and their dependents, plus retirees, have unlimited shopping privileges at any exchange. Military ID is required.
