- ★ Only one plain 4 mm-6 mm earring (shiny/brushed matte finish, screw-on/with posts) may be worn per ear, centered on earlobe
- ★ Earrings are not authorized for men while in uniform/duty status

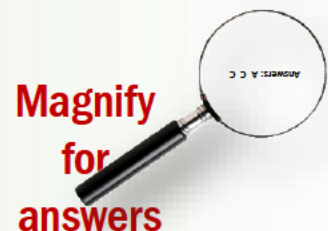
