

Resources for BLS Certification (Renew BLS: Every 24-months and before expiration of previous certification)

Places to Look

- Your federal agency (usually free)
- Other federal and military instillations (usually free)
- Local hospitals
- Emergency Medical Service (EMS) facilities
- Facility where clinical hours are performed
- Local Community Health Centers and/or Federally Qualified Health Centers
