- 6. Been recognized with exceptional ratings on annual performance evaluations and with awards presented by the USPHS, agency, and/or regional or national public health and dental organizations.
- 7. Undertaken significant professional development courses or fields of study.
- 8. Substantiated dedication to the principles of the USPHS through consistent and active participation and leadership in DePAC working groups, USPHS-affiliated organizations, organized dentistry, and/or community involvement/outreach efforts.

If applicable, I certify that I have been Basic Ready for the entire award duration period, or for the entire five years before nomination (whichever is shorter).
