#### **Dental Staff Clinical Specialist,** USCG AIRSTA Clearwater, Clearwater, FL

Provide diagnostic, restorative and emergency dental care for USCG Active Duty members in order to maintain members' dental readiness for unrestricted worldwide deployment. Prevent and control dental disease, promote dental health, refer to specialists, prioritize delivery of care in order to meet operational readiness requirements, ensure follow up care when needed, conduct monthly peer reviews, oversee dental assistant and hygienist, provide 24 hour emergency on-call coverage, and conduct collateral duties as assigned.

## Staff Dental Officer, USCG TRACEN Cape May, Cape May, NJ

Provide diagnostic, restorative and emergency dental care primarily for US Coast Guard Recruits and some Active Duty members in order to maintain members' dental readiness for unrestricted worldwide deployment. Prevent and control dental disease, promote dental health, refer to specialists, ensure follow up care when needed and prioritize delivery of care in order to meet operational readiness requirements, provide 24 hour emergency on-call coverage on a rotating basis, conduct monthly peer reviews and assist in overseeing duties of Dental Assistants (8) and Dental Hygienists (3).

#### Digital Dental Radiology Officer

Ensure proper storage of all digital dental radiology equipment and supplies in clinic, inspection of all radiology supplies including: sensors, lead shields, and aprons for any defects, associated record keeping: patient log, repeat analysis, dental imaging reports, train staff in dental radiology procedures as needed, review and update dental radiology protocol, cleaning of radiology equipment.

#### Quality Improvement Coordinator (QIC)

Ensure health care problems in clinic are identified and resolved, develop and promulgate annual Quality Improvement calendar, direct activities for the quarterly QIFG meetings and all monitoring and evaluation activities, advise senior health services officer on all QI related matters.

#### **Medical Sterilization Monitoring Officer**

Labeling all autoclaves to be monitored by name, date, number and location; ensure autoclaves are maintained in accordance with manufacturer specifications; notifying supply petty officer when autoclaves due for routine preventive maintenance; ensure weekly testing using biological indicator tests performed on all sterilization equipment, maintain a log documenting all biological indicator testing performed with dates and test results; notify clinic supervisor of any positive test results and ensure sterilizers testing positive are taken out of service until repaired; assure adequate test supplies are procured and maintained in stock

#### Infectious Waste, Prevention and Control Officer

Maintain compliance with state infectious waste management policies and regulations; develop and maintain a clinic infectious waste management protocol; ensure clinic employees understand and comply with basic principles and practices of infection control; ensure proper storage of infectious waste and maintain clinic infectious waste disposal log; perform regular risk assessments ensuring quarterly inspections documented and coordinate with the clinic training officer to provide annual refresher training

#### Dental Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) Officer

Update and format Clinic's Dental SOP, coordinate with employees and ensure their reading and understanding of the SOP and obtain annual clinic signatures

#### **Ouality Assurance Records and Peer Review Officer**

Maintain monthly peer review records, review data trends in peer review to identify areas of improvement, provide data to Senior Dental Executive

#### **Quality Assurance Focus Group Member**

Attend quarterly meetings with medical & dental providers and staff to identify areas of improvement in the clinic, provide committee reports to QA director for updates each quarter

#### Health Services Training Coordinator

Coordinate weekly trainings for entire USCG unit medical/dental clinic, organize and track mandatory trainings contributing towards accreditation (AAAHC, HPAP) preparedness

#### Social Coordinator Officer

Coordinate morale events for dental clinic employees (ie. assistant appreciation lunch, birthdays, retirements, etc.), coordinate special events with dental officers for transfers or retirements, and serve as POC for outside venues

#### Safety Data Sheet (SDS) Officer

Oversight of SDS binder in clinic, ensure new SDSs added to binder, ensure emergency numbers for all materials up-to-date
