Background

- PHEP undertook the creation of a database for certifiable skills used by Engineering Officers
- Skills database generated based on previous PHEP work and investigations
 - Current effort is focused on providing a process for capturing, vetting, and tracking skill sets
- Skills tied to OPDIVs and PHS mission.
 - Currently not looking at job functions with OPDIVs
- Database being tied to other subcommittee work, for example mentoring
 - Career Development for matching mentor/mentee based on skills
 - Readiness to generate lists of skills to meet Deployment Missions needs
 - Ongoing work that will impact outside of EPAC for providing a process and mock-up of a system to track skills
- All screenshots of documents are working drafts



Categorizing Skills - Benchmark Validation

- Skills are labeled as benchmark or non-benchmark
- Benchmark skills meet a high level of standard
- Non-benchmark skills are included and seen as added value for OPDIV and/or PHS
- Skills can be technical or administrative



- Powerful tool that can be used for deployments, hiring, mentoring, and much more





Moving Forward

Ongoing

- Complete certifiable skills database and SOPs (December 2020)
- PHEP will continue to work with other Subcommittees to enhance the database Access file
- Currently, CCHQ calls officers to verify self-reported skills for future missions
 - Process has potential for providing updated and vetted lists on USPHS Engineers that possess needed skills
- Database will assist with deployments, promotions, officer development, and hiring agencies
