



► Background:

The U.S. Public Health Service Engineers have been instrumental in supporting the Corps' mission to protect, promote, and advance the health and safety of our Nation, through work with their respective Agencies and by serving on deployments.



Introduction


Agency work often allows for an abundance of resources and time, which may not always be the case while on deployment. Deployments can demand skill sets, resources, and experiences that may not be readily available to the engineer.

For example, a Sanitation Facilities Construction (SFC) engineer with water and sewer construction experience in a hot climate called to serve in colder regions might be unfamiliar with the principles of cold region engineering. The lack of knowledge and experience can be a barrier to effective mission completion.

Additionally, the DST technical support is also offered to engineers serving in remote locations who are in need of additional resources to support their agency duties.

DST Team General Selection Criteria

1. Team Lead and members:

- 1. Three-year term (with a two-term limit)
- 2. Two officers per discipline/role (minimum)

2. Member selection criteria:

- 1. Professional Engineer (P.E.) or equivalent licensure/certification in their field.
- Minimum of five years of experience performing at the professional level (or equivalent).





Recognition for Excellence in Physical fitness

program (REP!)

USPHS has a Recognition for Excellence in Physical fitness program, known as the REP! program. The REP! program is aligned under the Surgeon General's Team (SGT) that includes Public Health Service Athletics and embodies the Surgeon General's Team Core values of health promotion, outreach, visibility, and leadership. The SGT is a health outreach program created by the Office of the Surgeon General to strengthen the relationships of Corps officers with their own communities located all across the U.S. and abroad.

The REP! program shares in the mission to protect, promote, and advance the health of the American people through fitness, starting with our own officers, and recognizing them for going above and beyond on the Annual Physical Fitness Test.

We encourage you to make it one of your fitness goals this year to up your APFT game by increasing your APFT level or achieving an Outstanding or Maximum level.

The REP! program's purpose is to motivate and recognize PHS officers with a certificate for achieving high or increasing levels of physical fitness, meeting the following APFT accomplishments:

- 1. LEVEL INCREASE (Minimum requirement: Increase from Satisfactory to Good)
- 2. OUTSTANDING/MAXIMUM LEVEL
- 3. 3 YEAR-OUTSTANDING/MAXIMUM LEVELS


