Professional Certifications and Credentials Project (Project Lead: LCDR Tom Peter – Thomas.Peter@fda.hhs.gov)

- Status Update
 - o No update since last month.
 - o Waiting from CCHQ to inform CPO about how licensure and credentials are considered in the promotion process.
- Challenges
 - Unclear when CCHQ will provide the information that is necessary for us to move forward
- Next milestone
 - o Hoping to receive guidance to make the necessary whitepaper revisions in time for a September 2023 EPAC vote on website republication.

- Status Update:
 - o Still on hold until CCHQ confirms or denies there will be changes to promotion benchmarks typically released in July/August timeframe.
 - o Current CV Template follows CCHQ guidance.





- EPAC General Meeting info: No changes to the CV and it will be required for PY2023.
- Challenges/problems/request for feedback:
 - o Waiting on CCHQ; cannot progress.
 - o If you working on your CV, utilize the version on the EPAC website and not the CCMIS website as it is not formatted well.
- Next milestone:
 - o The "Perfect" Engineer CV guidance document is also on hold until CCHQ guidance is provided.

- Status Update

- Next milestone
 - o 31 JUL to finalize report; and send to PHS listserv.

Council of Captains (Project Lead: CDR David Dar - David.Dar@fda.hhs.gov)

- Status Update
 - o Panel #5 held with 109 participants. Received largely positive feedback; kudos to LCDR Chang for excellent moderation.
 - o November Senior Officer Panel on "Maximizing your Deployment Experience"
- Challenges
 - o Need to select panelists and confirm moderator/coordinator.
 - o Interaction with Readiness Committee (CDR Marcus Yambot), who's planning an event to cover deployments (more so task-oriented/logistics/etc.)
 - Some feedback that officers were disappointed in the messaging from the Senior Officer Panel.
 - o CDR Dar going on paternity leave and A/L shortly; planning for others to lead the planning efforts for the next Senior Officer Panel. Will announce once confirmed.
- Next milestone
 - Panel #6 to be held on November 17, "Maximizing the Deployment Experience"
 - Scheduled internal CDS meeting for Thursday to discuss planning.

- Status Update
 - o EPA Document being reviewed by other engineers in EPA; first draft to be received by August 5 from CDR Yonce
 - The IHS document draft has been received and is being reviewed by our team. Led by LT Pfister. Still need to send out to CAPT
 - OS/ASPR document draft: CAPT Savalia has reviewed and provided comments. Typical degrees, certifications, trainings need to be added to the document still. Our team is reviewing these comments
 - o Asked LT Tim Beck if he can contact CDR Deborah Dee as a resource for the CDC document. No other updates.

 - OCDS Leadership to check with EPAC leadership on whether a vote is needed on the Career Track Guidance Reports
