 - o Submitted revised whitepaper to EPAC leadership on 9/23/2022 for further review and approval

Promotion Data Analytics (Project Lead LCDR Tim Martin – <u>Timothy.Martin@hhs.gov</u>); presented by LCDR David Sullivan

- Status Update
 - O PY2022 survey closed on 8/16, and we received a 67% response rate: 72 responses out of a possible 108 officers, who were eligible for promotion (~140 officers actually up for promotion; not all promotion packets reviewed).
 - o 67 of the 72 were deemed acceptable as 2 were duplicates (thank you to those 2 officers to assure we got their response!) and 3 were unable to be confirmed legitimate.
 - Visuals are being generated and incorporated into the reporting format utilized for last year's due out
