Professional Certifications and Credentials Project (Project Lead: LCDR Tom Peter – Thomas.Peter@fda.hhs.gov

- Status Update
 - Team met to disposition the survey responses that came from BMEs
 - We agreed to exclude some responses from our analysis, but they will be used to recommend benchmarks clarification
 - 12 responses required additional research to determine if they should be included in our analysis (in-progress; 8 of 12 are complete)
- Challenges/problems/request for feedback
 - Two team members are currently deployed and at least one other has been rostered for deployment
- Next scheduled milestone with date
 - Analyze survey results to understand the different certifications held by BMEs (results for engineering disciplines will be analyzed later)
 - Select some certifications as good examples to be included in biomedical engineer (BME) whitepaper
 - We hope to complete these tasks by end of May 2021, but deployments may impact this timeline
