Advanced Readiness Program Application

The Advanced Readiness is a voluntary program under which Health Service Officers (HSOs) could increase their deployment and technical capabilities as defined by their respective Professional Advisory Groups (PAGs). Please complete the following application to enroll in the Advanced Readiness program.

Pre-requisites for Advanced Readiness:

- The Advanced Readiness Program is open to all HSOs who are on active duty in the Commissioned Corps for at least 5 years based on the latest entry on duty date on PIR.
- Basic Readiness: Must have met all basic readiness requirements in the 12 months prior to the date of application.
- Field Readiness: Must have demonstrated field readiness via Field Medical Readiness Badge (FMRB) in PIR or all required FMRB courses completed in Responder e-Learn or a total of 7 days of agency and/or RDB deployments.
- No current or pending adverse actions.

Application package must include:

- Completed officer demographic section of this document, including name, rank, email address, PHS serial number, agency and PAG. Ensure all information provided are accurate and true.
- Documentation showing field readiness (such as screenshot of FMRB in PIR, list of FMRB courses completed in Responder e-Learn or orders for agency and/or RDB deployments).
- Screenshot(s) documenting Basic Readiness compliance for the past 12 months.
- Upon completion of the document, send the completed application package to
 <u>ADVANCEDREADINESS HSPAC@LIST.NIH.GOV.</u> You may save it as a MS Word or PDF document.
 Include your last name and application date as part of the file name (e.g., Advanced Readiness Application OfficerLastName 20191201).

Please note, your application will not be processed if any information is missing.
