Put Your Best Boot Forward for Promotion!

Step Up to the Mic

Every officer has a unique career narrative, and your promotion packet should depict your leadership abilities and the positive impact you've made in your career!



Where to Begin?

Embarking on the journey towards promotion can be both exciting and challenging! Here are a few tips for putting together your COER and promotion documents.

- Start Early: Create an organized binder or digital folder of <u>accomplishments</u> & <u>impacts</u>
- Familiarize yourself with current promotion related policies
 - check out <u>HSPAC Promotion Policy Resource Guide</u> (10/23)
- Review <u>benchmarks</u> & <u>guidance</u> for <u>COER</u> / promotion documents (<u>CV</u>, <u>CV</u> <u>Cover Page</u>, <u>CE Summary Sheet</u>, <u>OS</u>, <u>ROS</u>)
 - review against the benchmarks at the next higher rank
- Write a strong Officer Statement (OS): What you do for PHS
- Reviewing Officials Statement (ROS): What you do for your agency
 Draft &/or provide bullets for your ROS
- Quantify your achievements! Tie in benchmarks
- Communicate regularly with your supervisor, so that there are no surprises with your COER (know where you stand & where you may need to improve)
- Write concise sentences/bullets
 - \circ $\;$ will depend on template/guidance for each document on what's best
- Proofread
- Seek feedback (<u>Mentor</u>/Trusted Colleague)
- Do not deviate from the format
- Know the submission <u>deadlines</u>; don't want until the last minute to submit
 - o Submission deadline tied to <u>NIST</u> clock, not your local/computer time
