## **Position Description**

Position Title: Health Services Professional Advisory Committee's (HS PAC) Recruitment & Retention (R & R) Subcommittee Agency Liaison

Purpose: The purpose of the liaison role is to serve as a link between the HS PAC's R & R committee and all HHS agencies and U.S. Public Health Service (U.S. PHS) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) agencies for employment placement purposes.

## **Functions:**

- 1. Maintain name and contact information for agency liaison/national recruiter.
- 2. Establish a mechanism for obtaining monthly listing of current and anticipated employment opportunities for U.S. PHS officers and applicants.
- 3. Work with the agency recruiter for list of employment opportunities or utilize USAJobs and the Commissioned Corps list server for employment listings.
- 4. Maintain a listing of employment opportunities in an excel spreadsheet.
- 5. Provide listing to the HS PAC R & R committee Chair monthly.
- 6. Communicate to the HS PAC R & R subcommittee Chair new information in advance of the monthly R & R subcommittee meeting.
- 7. Prepare and submit a monthly written report of activities and new information.
- 8. Update relevant action items as appropriate.

## **Objectives**

- 1. Maintain a real time list of employment opportunities that can be shared with the Health Services Applicant Placement Program (HSAPP) Discipline Liaisons and posted in the HS PAC newsletter.
- 2. Enable Health Service Officers greater access to available commissioned corps eligible positions.
