The 2-week OBC is mandatory for all officers appointed and called to active duty after 30 September 2008, and introduces new officers to fundamental concepts in officership, leadership, readiness and public health.

The officers and civilian personnel named above have consistently demonstrated their support of OBC, contributing their time, creativity and expertise as Adjunct Faculty on a monthly basis.
