- 35 MLSPAG officers complete the surveys with no 20+ year officer responded. Majority of responders are 04 and 05 rank.
- 34% majority of survey responders said the award system had very little help & most officers got help from a mentor or coworker.
- Tips for award writing: Write-ups need to be impactful and data filled, & written similar to previous successful awards for that agency.
- Variation of responses for knowing what is worthy of an award.
- FMRB question 44% of responders are clinical ready- rest 8 have the FMRB before the changes to the APFT, 7 people don't have the FMRB, and 2 did received it after APFT the changes.

- 48/90 possessed their FMRB = 53.33%
- 13/90 met all requirements but had not yet been awarded the FMRB = 14.44%

### **Advanced Readiness Program (ARP)**
