El Paso Station is the busiest 2200 patients (i.e. detainees) were seen. The biggest bus had 265 patients (i.e. detainees). CDR Howard was taking temperatures, pregnancy test, blood pressure, trauma situations, support groups, therapy groups, etc. Overall GREAT Deployment Opportunity.

The U.S. Public Health Service (USPHS) Commissioned Corps continues to assist the Department of Homeland Security/U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) with medical screenings of family unit aliens (FMUAs) and unaccompanied children (UAC) at border patrol stations along the SW border.
