30.303	Determine, within the limits fixed by the Secretary under Section 206(d) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 207(d)), for any fiscal year, for each category in the Regular Corps, the maximum number of officers authorized to be in each of the grades from Assistant to Director, inclusive.	7/31/78	Dir, CPOD/ OPM/OM

30.304	Increase by one, whenever a vacancy exists in a category, the number fixed under the above authority for the next lower grade in the same category, without regard to the numbers fixed in regulations under Section 206(d) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 207(d)), and in the event the vacancy in the higher grade shall not be filled except by a permanent promotion, and upon the making of such promotion the number of the next lower grade shall be reduced by one.	7/31/78	Dir, CPOD/ OPM/OM
30.305	Exercise within the numerical requirements prescribed by the Assistant Secretary for Personnel Administration under Section 210(1) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 211(1)) for the total commissioned corps active duty strength for each of the several grades, the authority to determine the numerical requirements for commissioned officers for each grade of each category.	7/31/78	Dir, CPOD/ OPM/OM
