Section A. Purpose and Scope

This INSTRUCTION lists the authorities relating to the training of PHS commissioned officers and the officials who may exercise these authorities.

35.101	Approve, for officers assigned to their respective organizations, short-term training outside the Service for not to exceed seven semester hours and/or 90 consecutive calendar days under authority of Section 218(a) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 218a(a)) and PHS Regulations prescribed in Subchapter CC45.2, 11, CCPM.	11/13/74	DPSOs/ OASH, PHS AHs, RHAs, ADM EPA
35.102	Authority to collect from former commissioned officers of PHS indebtedness to the Government, incurred as a result of failure to complete a period of obligatory service, under authority of Section 218(b) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 218a(b)).	7/17/78	PHS AHs
35.103	Waive reimbursement, in whole or in part, as required by Section 218(b) of the PHS Act (42 U.S.C. 218a(b)) by an officer who voluntarily leaves the Service within specific periods after completion of training, if it is determined the reimbursement would be inequitable or would not be in the public interest.	**1/22/79	Dir, OM/PHS
