Subchapter CC42.3--Incentive Pay
Personnel INSTRUCTION 1--Increased Pay and Allowances for Participation
in Aerial Flights

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Section A. Purpose and Scope

This regulation prescribes the conditions under which an officer who participates in aerial flights shall be entitled to Hazardous Duty Incentive Pay.

Section B. Authority

This regulation is prescribed under the authorities of 37 U.S.C.301; Section 210(a) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 210(a), 216); Executive Order No. 11157, and 29 FR 7973, as amended, 50 FR, 54511. This regulation will be implemented in INSTRUCTION 1, Subchapter CC22.3, of the Commissioned Corps Personnel Manual (CCPM).

Section C. Non-Rated Flight Crew Members

Non-Rated Crew Members. Except as otherwise designated by the Secretary, officers who perform primarily full-time duty on board an aircraft, to accomplish the primary mission of the flight, in accordance with competent orders, shall be designated as a non-rated aircrew member, pursuant to section 204(a)(1) of the Career Compensation Act of 1949, as amended, and shall be entitled to the pay authorized by subsection (c) of such section (37 U.S.C. 301(a)(1)).

Section D. Non-Crew Members

Non-crew Members. Except as otherwise designated by the Secretary, all other duty performed under competent orders by commissioned officers involving frequent and regular participation in aerial flights shall be as a non-crew member pursuant to section 204(a)(3) of the Career Compensation Act of 1949, as amended and shall be entitled to the pay authorized by subsection (c) of such section (37 U.S.C. 301((a)(2))).
