SUBCOMMITTEES

Officer Involvement and Outreach Subcommittee:

This subcommittee increases awareness of and participation in JOAG among recently commissioned junior officers. Each month, email messages are sent to junior officers celebrating their one-year anniversary as an active duty officer with the USPHS Commissioned Corps. Additional projects include contacting officers when they are promoted to O-3 and O-4 to encourage them to join JOAG if they are not already a member, sending welcome information to junior officers when they join the JOAG list serv, and coordinating with the Meet & Greet Subcommittee to contact officers interested in JOAG, but not already actively involved.

Standard Operating Procedures Subcommittee:

This subcommittee reviews and updates the JOAG Membership Committee's SOPs, as needed, for consistency and formatting.

Voting Membership Subcommittee:

This subcommittee facilitates the annual selection process for new JOAG voting members.

Meet and Greet Subcommittee:

This subcommittee organizes and develops opportunities through which junior officers in a city/region can be introduced to JOAG, learn about JOAG volunteer opportunities, network, discuss issues relating to the Commissioned Corps, and be provided with professional support and advice.

Listserv Subcommittee:

This subcommittee maintains a spreadsheet of JOAG listserv members, and coordinates with the Meet & Greet and Officer Involvement and Outreach Committees to ensure that new and interested officers are added to the JOAG listserv and receive information on JOAG opportunities.
