VI. ADJOURNMENT—NEXT MEETINGS: The APAOC meeting was adjourned at 1246 hours.

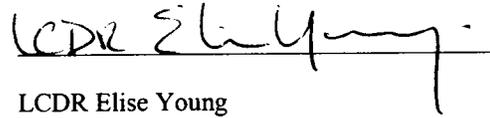
