The Therapist Officer Professional Advisory Committee (TPAC) of the US Public Health Service Commissioned Corps has developed a program to assist therapist applicants to the Corps in finding a qualified position with one of our Agencies, and to answer questions concerning the commissioning process. I am one of the liaisons that have volunteered to be part of this program.

The Call to Active Duty (CAD) Team at the Division of Commissioned Corps Personnel and Readiness (DCCPR) will remain your primary contact regarding your commissioning. The objective of our program is to provide additional mentorship from current Commissioned Corps therapists.

I am attaching a current vacancy list for Therapy positions. There is a Point of Contact listed for each position, and I would encourage you to make initial contact with this person via phone or email. This list consists of clinical positions, which are a priority to fill for new calls to active duty. We may also be able to provide contacts for non-clinical positions within the PHS, however, these non-clinical positions may be a lower priority to fill, which could potentially delay or hinder your commissioning process.
